- Ensure that all copyright clearances have been obtained to present and publish.

Submit an abstract and summary online:

- Please submit a 150- 200 word text abstract for review purposes. NZALT Conference 2012 Chair/Editor is authorized to circulate your abstract to conference committee members for review and selection. If accepted, this summary text will be published online or in printed programmes promoting the conference.
- Abstracts should contain enough detail to clearly convey the key message of the paper.

Review, Notification, and Program Placement Information

- To ensure a high-quality conference, all submissions will be assessed by the Conference Chair/Editor for suitability of content.
- Conference Chair/Editors reserve the right to not accept for presentation any paper that does not meet content or presentation expectations.
- The contact author will receive notification of acceptance and presentation details by e-mail no later than 19 February 2012.

Proceedings / Peer-reviewed papers

- Authors may wish to have a full written paper of their presentation refereed with a view to publication in conference proceedings. In common with practice for the 2008 and 2010 biennial conferences, proceedings will be published in a special issue of *The New Zealand Language Teacher*, to be published at the end of 2012.
- If you wish to submit a full paper for consideration in proceedings, please indicate this when submitting your abstract by 15th December 2011. The full written paper will need to be submitted by 30th April 2012 to the Editor of *The New Zealand Language Teacher*, Dr. Martin East (m.east@auckland.ac.nz).
