The 33rd Annual General Meeting of the New Zealand Association of Language Teachers will be held in Auckland at a Conference 2006 venue at 4.35 p.m. on Tuesday, 4 July, 2006.

Remits and Constitutional Amendments

Remits and notices of constitutional amendments for consideration at the Annual General Meeting should be forwarded to the Secretary of NZALT at PO Box 12-237, Thorndon, Wellington by 31 May at the latest **IN THE FORM IN WHICH THEY ARE TO BE PRESENTED TO THE MEETING**. They should be accompanied in each case by the names of the proposer and seconder and an explanatory statement. All remits and notices of amendment received by the due date will be circulated, and Regional Officers or sub-regional officers will organise meetings for members to discuss them prior to the AGM. Members are reminded that remits and notices of amendment cannot be accepted at the meeting itself.

A copy of the Constitution may be obtained from the NZALT web-site, Regional Officers or the Secretary.

Nominations for the National Executive.

Nominations are called for the following positions: **Regional Officers for all regions; Junior Vice-President; Secretary.**

Nominations must be signed by a proposer and seconder, and by the nominee as an indication of willingness to stand. A brief statement of the nominee's qualifications for the position should be appended, which will be circulated should a ballot be necessary. All nominations will be acknowledged.

Nominations for the above positions should be in the hands of the Secretary by Wednesday 31 May, so that voting papers can be prepared for postal ballots where necessary. Voting for Regional Officers will be carried out only in regions where this is required.
